and Tryon Field & Mtn.

At Bradbury Mountain—528 Hallowell Road:

- * **10:00 AM**—Guided snowshoe hike with Maine naturalist Jeff Pengel. Meet at the park pavilion.
- * Maine Mammals display: furs, scat, and tracks.
- * Warming fire and hot cocoa while it lasts!
- * **1:00 PM**—Snow themed story hour and snow activities near the pavilion.
- * **5:45 PM**—Star gazing on top of Bradbury Mountain at with nighttime expert James Shields. Begins at 6PM at the summit. Hike up on your own or meet the ranger at the pavilion at 5:45 PM to hike up the short but steep summit trail as a group. Star Program will last about an hour. Bring a red-lens flashlight or headlamp.
- * Ski & Snowshoe Trailer on site with free equipment loans.

At Tryon Fields and Mountain—park in Tryon lot off Lawrence Road:

- * Groomed sliding hill at Tryon Fields; bring your own sled.
- * **1:00 PM**—Guided snowshoe hike with Maine naturalist Jeff Pengel.
