<u>DEFINITIONS</u> (Title 7 MRSA Sec 2211)

NURSERY STOCK MEANS:

- **A.** Woody plants, including ornamental and fruiting trees, shrubs, vines and all viable parts of these plants;
- **B.** Herbaceous plants, including florist stock plants, annuals, perennials, vegetable seedlings, herbs, potted plants and all viable parts of these plants;
- **C.** Any other plant or plant part designated by the commissioner.

FEE SCHEDULE

- 1. An applicant who has a nursery stock retail sales area in excess of 150 square feet **or** gross annual sales of nursery stock in excess of \$500 shall pay a license fee of \$25 per year.
- 2. An applicant who has gross annual sales of nursery stock of \$500 or less and a nursery stock retail sales area of less than 150 square feet shall pay a license fee of \$5 per year.
- **3.** Educational institutions are exempt from a license fee.
